### Welcome to CCMoA's Annual Members' Juried Exhibition!

In this year's "call for art" artists were asked to submit works showing the influence Cape Cod has on their art-making. A record number of entries were received -375 artworks by 161 artists! Only 74 artworks were selected by Laura Shabott, juror. Selections include representational, abstract and non-objective works. Artist statements, explaining their Cape Cod influence, are positioned next to every work, adding to the viewing experience.

### **Juror's Statement**

Any number of exhibitions could have been created because the quality of the artworks submitted was very high. I built this particular show from three pillars: movement, mark making and visceral experience. Whether the genre was abstract, en plein air, realist, figurative, or somewhere in between, I looked for movement in the work; a life force or spark. The hardest part of this process was having to pass on so many pieces of art embodying that joie de vivre.

My second pillar was the element of composition. I teach painting and drawing through the eyes of the late Hans Hofmann, Fritz Bultman, Helen Frankenthaler, and contemporary Robert Henry; icons of Provincetown's art colony. This was a factor in the selection process. Did the bones of the piece, its simplest parts, work?

Last, a third fundamental, one almost impossible to define, was the visceral experience of grouping works together to create a narrative. What I know about curation I learned through a decade of gallery assistance at the Berta Walker Gallery. She taught me that artworks talk to each other when creating a show.
